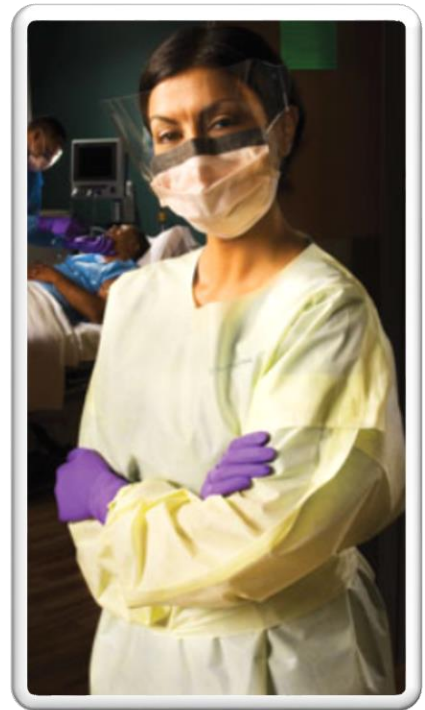
This free training consists of two parts:
