## COVID-19 Pfizer Booster Vaccine for Specific Groups to begin in North Central Health District

Advisers to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have recommended a third dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine.

Those eligible for a single booster dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine are those who received their second dose of the Pfizer vaccine at least six months earlier and who falls into one of these categories:

- People ages 65 years and older
- Residents of long-term care facilities
- People ages 50-64 with underlying medical conditions
- People ages 18-49 with underlying medical conditions, based on individual benefit and risk
- People ages 18-64 at an increased risk of exposure and transmission due to the type of work they do (including teachers and healthcare workers) or because they live or work in an institutional setting

Booster shots will be available at any location where the Pfizer vaccine is available. To find a list of COVID-19 vaccine providers, visit www.vaccinefinder.org.

Public Health – Idaho North Central District will be holding community booster clinics at their Lewiston Office location beginning next week. A walk-in clinic will be available on September 30<sup>th</sup> from 9am – 11am. For those interested in making an afternoon appointment, please schedule your appointment on-line at <a href="www.idahoprepmod.com">www.idahoprepmod.com</a>. Patients will need to bring their vaccination card with them to their appointment. Ongoing vaccination clinics will be held every Thursday at our Lewiston Public Health building, 215 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Lewiston, ID 83501.

The booster dose is for the Pfizer vaccine only. Data is still emerging as to whether an additional dose is necessary for individuals who received the Johnson & Johnson and the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine. There is no current recommendation for an booster dose for people who received these vaccines.
