## Idaho Farmers Market Recommendations During COVID-19 Pandemic

Farmers Markets must adhere to the requirements in the current <u>Stay Healthy Order</u>. This document provides Farmers Market Managers with additional strategies to protect the public's health during the novel coronavirus 2019 pandemic.

- 1. Instruct sick vendors to stay home and to follow the <a href="CDC's What to do if you are sick with coronavirus disease 2019">COVID-19</a>).
- 2. Require vendors in contact with patrons to wear cloth face coverings and gloves.
- 3. Direct the flow of traffic at the market to maximize space between people.
- 4. Use signage and barrier protection to limit movement and maintain distancing.
- 5. Booths sides and entrances should be placed to ensure a minimum of 6 feet between boundaries to minimize congregating between booths.
- 6. Arrange eating areas in a way that encourages physical distancing of groups.
- 7. Encourage vendors and customers to avoid occupying spaces between booths.
- 8. Provide additional handwashing stations for vendors and customers.
- 9. Do not allow tablecloths on tables and encourage frequent sanitization of tabletops.
- 10. Limit hand to hand contact by pre-packaging items and bagging loose items for customers. Vendors can set bags down to be picked up by the customers.
- 11. Encourage vendors to use a contactless payment and non-signature methods.
- 12. Monitor customer density and restrict entry as needed to ensure adequate room for social distancing.
