Idaho Temporary Event Recommendations During COVID-19 Pandemic

Temporary Event Vendors must adhere to the requirements in the current <u>Stay</u> <u>Healthy Order</u>. This document provides Vendors with additional strategies to protect the public's health during the novel coronavirus 2019 pandemic.

- 1. Stay home if you are sick and follow the <u>CDC's What to do if you are sick with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).</u>
- 2. Consider wearing cloth face coverings and gloves while working with patrons.
- 3. Direct the flow of traffic at your booth to maximize space between people.
- 4. Use signage and barrier protection to limit movement and maintain distancing.
- 5. Arrange booth so sides and entrances are a minimum of 6 feet between the next booth.
- 6. Arrange eating areas in a way that encourages physical distancing of groups.
- 7. Encourage customers to avoid occupying spaces between booths.
- 8. Provide additional handwashing station or sanitizer for patrons to use at your booth.
- 9. Do not use tablecloths on tables and frequently sanitization counters and tables.
- 10. Limit hand to hand contact by pre-packaging items and bagging loose items for customers. Set bags down to be picked up by the customers.
- 11. Use contactless payment and non-signature methods.
