

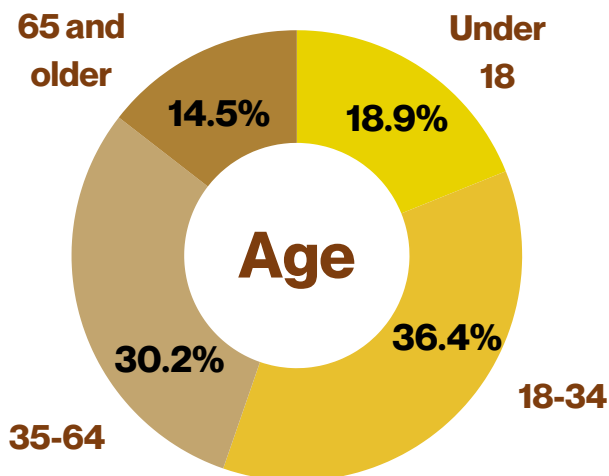
2023 Population Data and Trends

Our population increased by 810 residents from 2019 to 2023

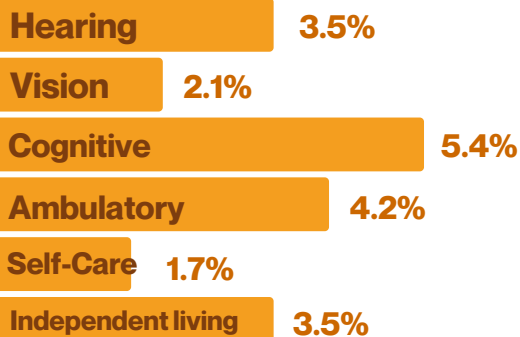

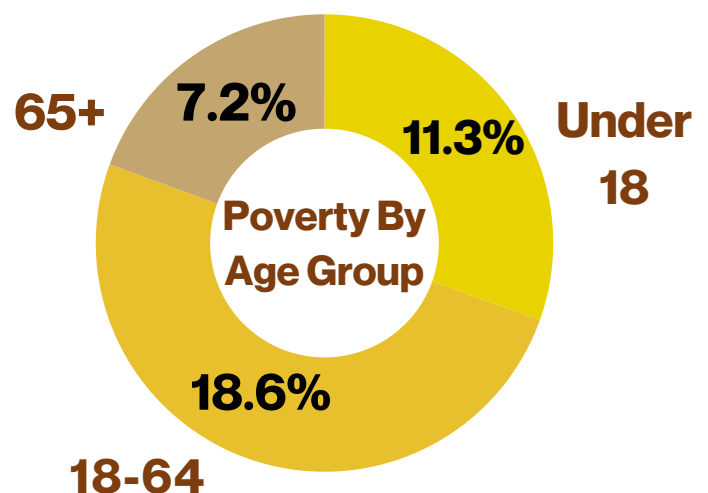

Educational Factors

What did educational attainment look like for Latah County in 2023?

46.1% of 3- and 4 year-olds were enrolled in preschool

96.9% of adults aged 25+ were high school graduates

44.9% of adults aged 25+ had bachelors degrees

Median value of owner-occupied homes increased 42% from 2019 to 2023.

Median Monthly Housing Costs

Year	Owner-occupied	Renter-occupied
2019	\$974	\$737
2023	\$1,118	\$905

Median monthly housing costs increased 14.8% for homeowners and 22.8% for renters.

29.1% of households in Latah County were housing cost burdened (spending 30% or more of their income on housing).

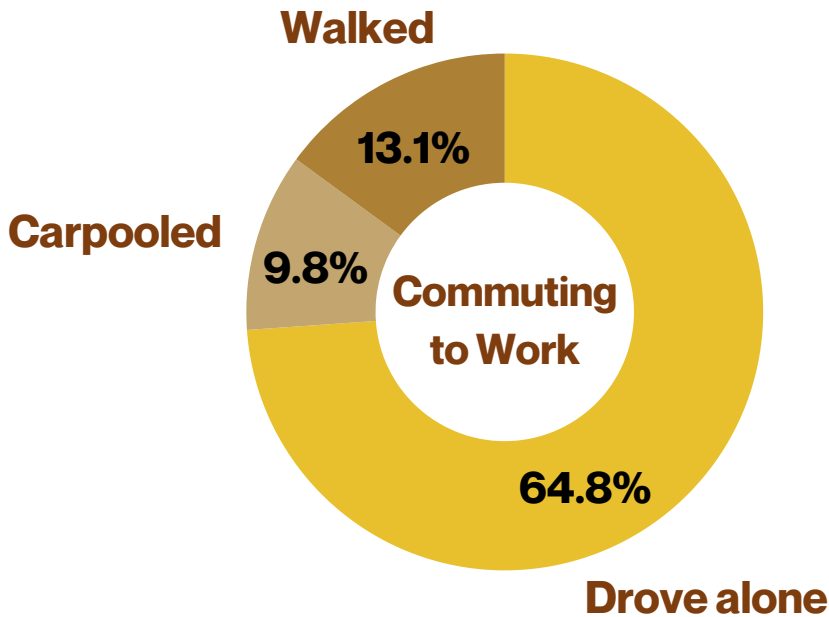
