**Updates on Legislation**..... Mike Kane

- Talked with Kratom bill sponsor, said she would consider changing age from 18 to 21. Bill was brought forward by the industry.
- S1283 Direct to Consumer Foods: sponsors not willing to change any language. Passed committees easily and should pass easily the rest of the way.
- S1326 Property rights and Gov access: Shouldn't be a big issue for PH, we don't go on private property without consent currently; IAC might have concerns because of assessors and coroners. What about PH nuisance complaints? Most nuisance related complaints are misdemeanors so if PH is refused entry, coordination with law enforcement would be best in these situations. This bill has law enforcement as being exempt.
- H758 daycare supervision numbers: PH is concerned about this; H&W have been notified as this is their program. They were going to reach out to bill sponsors to discuss. May be most successful if childcare providers come out in opposition as they did last year when a similar bill was proposed.
- New mosquito abatement bill, doesn't seem to have changed much. The same players will likely want to testify again if it is even heard.
- H743 violation of state law by government: if gov fails to perform a duty they are obligated to fulfill, they could be investigated and sued by the AG with a penalty of up to \$50k. This could be tricky when there are laws of the books that are very broad ("protecting the public's health in all ways"). IAC is also concerned about this.
